

"I Love the prayer with God . . .

Prayer; the most prominent symbol of the relationship between humans and their Creator. In prayer, a person speaks directly to God without intermediaries.

On the afternoon of Ashura and amid the battle, Imam Hussein (AS) was granted a request for a pause in the fighting and said: 'I pray in the form of love...' As the time for the noon prayer approached, one of the companions reminded Imam Hussein (AS) about the prayer time. Imam Hussein (AS) raised his head, looked at the sky, and made a supplication for him. The Master of Martyrs said, 'Ask the enemies to grant us time to perform the noon prayer... Imam and his companions stood up to say the noon prayer. Two of his companions named Zuhair ibn Qain and Saeed ibn Abdullah Hanafi stood in front of Imam Hussein (AS) and his companions to protect the worshipers from possible enemy attacks. At the start of the prayer, the enemy forces, outwardly appearing as Muslims, began to shower Imam Hussein (AS) and the other worshipers with arrows. However, Zuhair and Saeed shielded themselves from the enemy attacks. After the prayer concluded, Saeed ibn Abdullah attained martyrdom due to the severity of his injuries.

Reflection: Hussein (AS) is the martyr of upholding religion and prayer, the source of all goodness. A person's positive relationship with God also radiates its goodness to the surrounding community. The society moves away from degradation and towards excellence by following his virtues".
