

"Excerpt from the Tragedy of Ashura; The Last Moments of the Life of Imam Hussein (AS), the Grandson of the Prophet of Islam

In the final moments of the battle, the enemy forces under the command of Shimr ibn Dhil-Jawshan surrounded Hussein (AS). Shimr ordered the archers to rain arrows upon Imam Hussein. Due to the abundance of arrows, Imam's body was pierced by them. The injuries and fatigue had greatly weakened Hussein (AS). Therefore, he paused to rest for a moment. At this moment, a stone struck his forehead and blood began to flow from it. Just as Imam intended to wipe the blood off his face with the edge of his shirt (using a cloth or cloth piece), a three-pronged and poisoned arrow was shot towards him, lodging into his heart. Malik ibn Nusair struck a blow with his sword upon Hussein's (AS) head, severing the strap of his helmet.

By the order of Umar ibn Sa'ad and in accordance with the command of Ibn Ziyad, the commander of the enemy army in Karbala, ten volunteers from the forces of Kufa trampled the body of Imam Hussein (AS) with their horses and shattered the bones of his chest and back.

Reflection: Inhumane and barbaric acts in the name of a divine religion! Hussein ibn Ali (AS) was killed by some individuals who claimed to be Muslims in the name of religion and for the defense of religion! For the alleged crime of introducing a new form of heresy to the religion! Heavenly religions disapprove of any violent and extremist interpretations. Religions and their prophets have come to guide humanity towards a life of security and respect. The essence governing all religions is peace and peaceful coexistence. If someone cries out violence in the name of religion, they have neither understood religion nor its philosophy.
